

# REGIONAL BRAUNVIEH SHOW

SUPERINTENDENT: BAA Show Committee-Marilyn Brink

IN PLACE: Saturday, December 31, 12:00 p.m.

SHOW: Monday, January 2, 8:00 a.m.

BEGIN RELEASE: When done showing

ALL OUT: Monday, January 2, 10:00 p.m.

1. All entries must be halter broke to lead, as they will be shown individually in the Arena.
2. Animals competing in the Braunvieh Show must be registered in the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herd Book. A copy of the registration may be used for Braunvieh check-in. Any heifer not bearing a legible tattoo matching its registration paper is ineligible to show.
3. Exhibitors must be in good standing with the Braunvieh Association of America. Exhibitors must comply with the rules and regulations of the Cattlemen's Congress. All animals exhibited must have a DNA sample on file with the Braunvieh Association of America. A hair, tissue or blood sample on the subject animal must be received by the BAA or BAA representative prior to the show.
4. All animals exhibited must have a known Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its Braunvieh parent(s).
5. Animals must be Fullblood or Purebred to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh Show. Braunvieh Beef Builders will be shown in a separate Beef Builder Show. Cattle recorded as "Braunvieh Influence" with a "BI" prefix are not eligible.
6. The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPDs) values, ultrasound data (collected by a certified technician), scrotal circumference for bulls, weights and ratios for performance and weights with weight per day of age. These performance figures (including weights, hip heights and frame scores) can be presented in their entirety or any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.
7. Heifers born Sept. 1, 2020 and after will show in the heifer show but can show with natural calves at side and still be eligible to show for champion female/heifer.

8. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older (not females in the cow/calf class) must be pregnant and accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian or show with a natural calf at side. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.
9. Females born on or prior to Aug. 30, 2020 must show in the cow/calf class with a natural born calf at side. The pair will not be eligible for champion female/heifer. The registration of the cow (FB/PB or Beef Builder) will determine the division the pair shows in. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf class can be no more than 230 days of age by date of show. Calves from the cow/calf class can be entered as individuals in the show (additional entry fee)
10. Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. The certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months and older must be shown with a nose lead.
11. Braunvieh entries will be entered in a specific show class at time of entry.
12. No dyes, paints or other substances to alter animals' natural color will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification.
13. No cosmetic surgeries other than surgical dehorning will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification.
14. Only generally accepted fitting practices will be allowed. Violation will be cause for disqualification. Show committee will make ruling on a case by case basis. Animals disqualified will forfeit entry fees, awards and show points. Appeals will be forwarded to the ethics committee and Executive Vice President.
15. Protests will be made to the Show committee with a \$150.00 protest fee, within 24 hours of the show or prior to release, whichever is first, in writing to BAA staff or show committee members. If ruling in favor of protest, fee will be refunded. If ruling against, the fee will be forfeited.
16. Appeals will be made to the Show committee with a \$150.00 appeal fee. Appeal will be forwarded with all information to the ethics committee and Executive Vice President. If appeal granted, fee will be returned with reinstatement of show points and any other forfeited entry fees and awards. If appeal is denied, fee will be forfeited.
17. Decision of the ethics committee and Executive Vice President will be final.

## **GROUP CLASSES**

May include Beef Builders and/or Fullblood/Purebreds. All animals must be shown in their individual classes to be eligible.

- 27 Produce of Dam: Two (2) animals either sex from one dam, may be owned by one or more exhibitors.
- 28 Get-of-Sire: Three (3) animals, either sex, all by one sire may be owned by more than one exhibitor.
- 29 Breeder's Best Four Head: Four (4) animals, either sex, bred by one breeder. Not necessarily owned by the breeder or one exhibitor. Either or both sexes represented.

## **BEEFBUILDER / PERCENTAGE**

Entries in the Beefbuilder/Percentage classes and group classes will be made according to the same breakdown as the Fullblood/Purebred classes only using corresponding class numbers 31-42 for heifers, 43 for cow/calf and 44-56 for bulls.

The Cattlemen's Congress awards rosettes to Division Champions and Reserve Division Champions and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.

Refer to Cattlemen's Congress Pen Show Rules for show fees and entry procedures.

Animals must be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owner. Animals entered and exhibited in this division must be owned by an individual, corporation, partnership, and/or working family unit. Animals, or interest in animals sold by the original breeder or first owner may be entered and shown by the original breeder or first owner after transfer of ownership. Animals purchased as embryos, flushes or pregnancies may be shown by the purchaser as first Owner.

Animals competing in this Pen Show must be registered in the Braunvieh Association of America (BAA) Herd Book. A copy of the registration may be used for Braunvieh check-in. Any animal not bearing a legible tattoo matching its registration paper is ineligible to show.

Exhibitors must be in good standing with the Braunvieh Association of America. Exhibitors must comply with the rules and regulations of the Cattlemen's Congress. All animals exhibited must have a DNA sample on file with the Braunvieh Association of America. A hair, tissue or blood sample on the subject animal must be received by the BAA or BAA representative prior to the show.

All animals exhibited must have a known Braunvieh dam or sire and are subject to being DNA verified to its Braunvieh parent(s).

Animals must be Fullblood or Purebred to qualify for the FB/PB Braunvieh Pen Show.

Braunvieh Beef Builders will be shown in a separate Beef Builder Pen Show. Cattle recorded as “Braunvieh Influence” with a “BI” prefix are not eligible.

The BAA reserves the right to provide the judge and audience with the Expected Progeny Difference (EPDs) values, ultrasound data (collected by a certified technician), scrotal circumference for bulls, weights and ratios for performance and weights with weight per day of age. These performance figures (including weights, hip heights and frame scores) can be presented in their entirety or any combination deemed necessary by the BAA.

Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older must be pregnant and accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy by a licensed veterinarian or show with a natural calf at side. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.

Bulls exhibited at 14 months of age or older must have a positive semen test and a certificate to that effect. The certificate must be available for inspection. Bulls 12 months and older must be shown with a nose lead.

Rules 11-17 from the Congress Braunvieh Open Regional Braunvieh Show will also apply to the pen show.

Braunvieh and Beef Builder bulls and heifers shown in the pen show are eligible to show in the Open Braunvieh or Open Beef Builder show, but additional separate entry must be made. Pens will be exhibited in the class based off the oldest animal in the pen. Average age of the pen will not be considered.

The Cattlemen’s Congress awards banners to all Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
