

NATIONAL BRITISH WHITE OPEN SHOW

IN PLACE: Friday, December 30, 12:00 p.m.

SHOW: Sunday, January 1, 3:30 p.m.

BEGIN RELEASE: When done showing

ALL OUT: Thursday, January 1, 10:00 p.m.

1. All cattle must be registered in the Herd Books of the American British White Park Association (ABWPA) or British White Cattle Association of America (BWCAA). Entries with registrations "pending" or illegible tattoos, or improper tattoos as shown on the registration certificate at check - in time are ineligible for competition.
2. For the Youth Class, all British White animals must be officially recorded (registered) with either ABWPA or BWCAA by December 1 to be eligible to show at the National British White Show at the Cattlemen's Congress. The Open Class is exempt from the requirement.
3. Exhibitors are subject to the ABWPA special rules on class qualification as defined below.
 - a. Eligibility requirements are as follows:
 - i. Females: 87.50% (7/8th) pedigree or greater
 - ii. Bulls: 93.75% (15/16th) pedigree or greater
 - iii. Steers: 93.75% (15/16th) pedigree or greater
 - b. Heifer Classes: See birth date ranges of each class for eligibility below.
 - c. Bull Classes: See birth date ranges of each class for eligibility below.
 - d. Steer Classes: See birth date ranges of each class for eligibility below.
 - e. Cow/Calf Class: See birth date ranges for class eligibility below.
4. Entries in these classes are accepted with the understanding that the exhibitor agrees to abide by the Cattlemen's Congress rules in all respects.
5. All entries must be halter broke to lead, as they will be shown individually in the Arena.
6. Females that are 24 months of age or older must show in the Cow/Calf class with a calf at side. Calves exhibited in the cow/calf class cannot be over 280 days of age.

7. Cows born December 31, 2019 or earlier Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf.
8. Any female that qualifies for female classes in the Standard Classifications is not eligible to show in the cow/calf class.
9. Calves from the cow/calf class can be entered as individuals in the show.
10. All bulls 12 months old and older must be led with a nose lead at all times.
11. No dyes, paints or other substances to alter animals' natural color will be allowed. Violation will result in disqualification.
12. The exhibition of cattle displaying false hair will not be allowed.
13. Any product administered internally or used externally to alter the conformation of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the use of graphite, hemp or other similar substances externally and steroids or growth stimulants internally.
14. The act of artificially filling animals internally, which includes stomach pumping, drench tubes or any other method by mouth or esophagus, is prohibited.
15. Breed Superintendent reserves the right to split classes with 10 or more head depending on animals' birthdates in each particular class to additional classes.
16. The individual classes will be made up and divided after the cattle are checked in at the show. They will be judged from the youngest to the oldest within each class.
17. The Cattlemen's Congress awards rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserve Champions and banners to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions.
