

# **BEEFMASTER PROMOTION GROUP SANCTIONED OPEN SHOW**

ALL OUT: Thursday, January 12, 10:00 p.m.

1. Exhibitors must be members of the Beefmaster Promotion Group (BPG). All cattle must be registered with Beefmaster Breeders United (BBU). For and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in a BPG approved show, each exhibitor hereby releases BPG and their respective officials, sponsors, agents, directors, employees and representatives, from any and all claims, liabilities, suits and judgments, arising from or connected with the administration or use of any animal test, rule enforcement and the resulting decision or action based thereon.
2. Animals entered in group classes must have been shown in an individual class.
3. Heifers exhibited at twenty-four (24) months of age or older must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy, by a licensed veterinarian, or be nursing their natural, purebred calf-at-side. If a calf is over 6 months old, cow must be palpated safe in calf and so stated on health papers.
4. All bulls twenty (20) months of age or older that are exhibited must have passed a fertility examination given by a licensed veterinarian to be eligible to show.
5. All bulls 12 months old and older must be led with a nose lead at all times.
6. All animals must be shown with their hair coats lying downward and flat against their entire body. Hair trimming is permissible and must be done in those few areas such as the neck and portions of the topline of the animal which may not naturally lay flat against the body. Hair may not be trained or pulled upwards or forwards. No animals may have any foreign objects attached to it in any manner or have its natural color altered in a manner so as to change the conformation or appearance. An exhibitor who fails to abide by this rule will be dismissed from the arena and/or forfeit premiums, awards and points from the show.
7. The BPG Code of Conduct will be enforced.

1. Get-of-Sire: Three (3) animals, all by one (1) sire, both sexes represented. No ownership requirement.
2. Produce-of-Dam: Two (2) animals, either or both sexes produced by one (1) dam. No ownership requirement.

# **JBBA BEEFMASTER SANCTIONED SHOW**

BEGIN RELEASE: When done showing

ALL OUT: Thursday, January 12, 10:00 p.m.

1. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of Beefmaster Breeders United and the Junior Beefmaster Breeders Association. When an entry is made, exhibitors agree to abide by the rules and regulations established by the JBBA as well as the rules of the Show Management. Entries found to be misrepresented, or persons not abiding by the show rules, may be disqualified from showing.
2. Original BBU Certificates of Breeding (not copies) on each animal shown, including any calf at side, must be presented to the show superintendent at the time of cattle check-in. Application for a BBU Certificate of Breeding on calves less than 30 days of age must be presented. Official scramble registration papers with appropriate show stamp must be presented at check-in.
3. All heifers must be registered with BBU as a purebred and out of a BBU-Certified Purebred dam, Second Cross dam or as otherwise stated in the BBU By-Laws.
4. Exhibitors must be a current member in good standing of the JBBA. Exhibitors must be a minimum of six years old on January 1<sup>st</sup> and under the age of twenty-one years on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
5. Entries must be exhibited by the owner unless he or she owns two or more entries in the same class, whereupon another bona fide JBBA exhibitor may show one of the entries. If the entry is a pair, the cow must be exhibited by the exhibitor.
6. Any heifer that, in the opinion of a designated BBU official, would be a detriment to the breed, shall be removed from the show, regardless of any prior classification. Examples would be animals exhibiting signs of low fertility, genetic, or physical defects.
7. All BBU registered animals must be shown with their hair coats lying downward and flat against their entire body. Hair trimming is permissible and must be done in those few areas such as the neck and portions of the top line of the animal which may not lay flat against the body. Hair may not be trained upwards or forwards and/or pulled upwards or forwards on any part of the animal's body. No animals may have any foreign objects attached to it in any manner or have its

natural color altered in a manner so as to change the conformation or appearance. An exhibitor who fails to abide by this rule will be dismissed from the arena and/or forfeit premiums and awards.

8. Classes of animals shall be split as near to equal numbers as possible by the show superintendent.
