1. OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

a. Open Show: All animals entered will have at least one owner on record as a Regular or Junior Member of American Speckle Park Association at the time of the time Regional or National Shows' check-in. Be registered with ASPA and meet all requirements at the time of Regional or National Shows' entry deadline. Have Official Registered Status at the time of Regional or National Shows' published shows check in.

b. Speckled Park Junior Show: To be eligible to show in the Speckle Park Junior Show, each exhibitor must be a Member of the ASPA Junior Association at time of the show's check-in. Substitutions will only be permitted for animals within sex, according to the hosting show's deadline.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

- 2. Females being shown in the yearling heifer classes that were born prior to May 1 of the previous year are required to have certification of pregnancy prepared by a licensed veterinarian on or before October 1, 2023. Certificate must be presented at time of processing or animal(s) will be disqualified from competition and removed from the show barn.
- 3. Current year heifer and bull calves from cow/calf units may be shown separate from their dams in their respective classes for calendar year calves. However, if a cow/calf unit includes a heifer calf and the pair places Senior Champion or Reserve Senior Champion, the calf cannot be shown in the class for calendar year calves and must be shown with the dam in the Grand Champion class.
- 4. Classes will be split if the entries exceed eight animals. The classes will be split equally.
- 5. All Speckle Park entered in this show must be completely registered with the American Speckle Park Association before the show as purebred, appendix, or a minimum of 93.8% or

higher. Solid black animals which meet these requirements are eligible to be entered.

- 6. All Speckle Park shown in this sanctioned show must have a DNA certificate file number recorded on their registration certificate or be accompanied by a separate DNA certificate. If classes are offered for commercial cattle, a DNA certificate is not required.
- 7. The use of any PAINT product that alters the natural color of the animal is not allowed at the American Speckle Park Show. This rule will be strictly enforced and any animal in violation will be excused from the show. There will not be any aerosols allowed in the makeup ring area.
- 8. Exhibitors must wear a show harness clearly displaying their show number, both front and back, while showing. Exhibitors wearing show numbers on their hip or elsewhere will be denied entry into the show ring.
- 9. Exhibitors shall exhibit sportsmanship and professional behavior in and around the show ring. Abusive, discourteous, or threatening behavior towards judges, show officials, fellow exhibitors or ASPA authorized representatives will not be tolerated.
- 10. Animal ID and Herd Prefix verification may be via printed registration certificate or real time electronic representation of the ASPA database. If the Animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are not legible and cannot be read during processing, it will not be allowed to participate in the show. A fee of \$100 will be charged to the exhibitor for a DNA parentage test of said animal. If the animal ID and/or Herd Prefix are legible but are incorrect and/or no visible indications of a tattoo in either ear, the animal will not be allowed to show.
- 11. Each animal will be exhibited in its natural conformation and structure and without any alterations or modifications, with the exception of acceptable fitting and grooming practices.
 - a. NO pumping.
 - b. The use of any PAINT product (white or black) and/or the addition of any hair or hair-like substances will not be allowed at the ASPA Show. This rule will be strictly enforced and any animal in violation will be excused from the show. There will not be any aerosols allowed in the makeup ring area.
 - c. All bulls 9 months of age or older on publicized date of show must be shown with a nose lead.
 - d. After processing, should the number of entries in any class exceed practicality, authorized representatives of the SPA have the authority to "split" classes according to age and at the date of birth that best encourages fair competition.
 - e. Any exhibitor who loses control of his/her animal twice in the show ring will be required to remove the animal from the ring.

GROUP CLASSES

01 Senior Get-of-Sire - Four (4) animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.

02 Junior Get-of-Sire - Three (3) animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, 2021. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.

03 Produce-of-Dam - Two (2) animals, either or both sexes, both shown in their respective classes. Animals shown in this class need not be owned by the exhibitor.

Premier Breeder - Will be computed from breeder's placement in individual classes only as follows: three (3) points for each 1st; two (2) points for each 2nd; one (1) point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine a winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)

Premier Exhibitor - Will be computed from the exhibitor's placement in individual classes, only as follows: three (3) points for each 1st; two (2) points for each 2nd; one (1) point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine a winner shall be limited to five (5). (In case of a tie, group class placement will be used to determine the winner.)
