The Cattlemen's Congress will charge and collect an entry fee of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars per head entered. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds. All entries must be made online at www.cattlemenscongress.com. A negative BVD-PI test is required on all steers prior to entering the grounds. Open Show to all states and any interested person. All calves must be born on or after January 1, 2026.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

This Open Prospect Show is governed by all show rules and regulations.

CLASSES:

Steers are to be shown by weight. No breed classes. All exhibitors will be required to turn in their own weight in online. This will become the official weight. All prospect steers will be divided into classes according to this weight. Weigh back is 5%. The maximum weight for this division is 1000 pounds.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

Banners will be awarded for top 5 overall prospect steers.

The Cattlemen's Congress will charge and collect an entry fee of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars per head entered. All Canadian and International exhibitors must pay all fees in United States funds. All entries must be made online at www.cattlemenscongress.com. A negative BVD-PI test is required on all steers prior to entering the grounds. Open Show to all states and any interested person. All calves must be born on or after January 1, 2026.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

CLASSES:

Heifers are to be shown by weight. No breed classes. All exhibitors will be required to turn in their own weight online. This will become the official weight. All prospect heifers will be divided into classes according to this weight. Weigh back will be 5%. The maximum weight for this division is 1000 pounds.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

Grand Champion Prospect Heifer: One thousand (\$1000.00) cash award; Banner by Cattlemen's Congress

Reserve Grand Champion Prospect Heifer: Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars cash award, Banner by Cattlemen's Congress.

Banners will be awarded for 3-5 overall Prospect heifer/s
